**Camp Scholarships**

The economic troubles have every aspect of our society, including summer camps for our youth and children. The average camp costs \$180+ per child. If someone goes to two camps in a summer (Pre-Teen and GA for example or Pre-Teen and Youth) then it costs a family at least \$360 PER CHILD—if they have only one child.

Rather than force parents to choose which camp, we are trying to raise funds for our children with the idea that if they attend two camps in summer we will give them a scholarship for half of each camp.

Each student will be required to pay the non-refundable deposit for each camp. And once they have [paid their half we kick in with the second half.

Scholarship funds are limited to the funds donated for this and will be awarded on a first come first serve basis.

If you would like to help with our children make a check to CHBC and in the memo write children's scholarship fund.
